



Future looks healthy for the Cats

The Geelong Football Club created history today announcing NIB Health Funds Limited (NIB) as the Club's new shorts and match ball sponsor in a three year deal with the Club.

The sponsorship will see NIB's brand appear on Geelong's home and away playing shorts, replacing Ford who has appeared exclusively on the club's playing apparel. NIB's logo will also appear on the match ball at all Geelong home games.

"This is a significant announcement for our club and we are looking forward to a long and successful association with NIB," Geelong CEO Brian Cook said.

"NIB's philosophy and values match with ours and our respective business goals are along similar lines. We have the ability to work to help each other reach our goals.

"Our sponsorship of the Geelong Football Club is a key component in NIB's expansion strategy throughout Victoria and across Australia.
